

Long-Term Care Home Incentives

Tuition Support Program for Nurses

Who: Registered Nurses

Registered Practical Nurses

Nurse Practitioners

What: For every year of tuition reimbursed, the applicant must work a minimum of 1500hours within a 12-month period when working on a full-time bases, or 24 months if the applicant is working in a permanent part-time position.

Eligibility:

- Recent graduate from Canadian college or university
- Be registered with the College of Nurses (temporary registration does not qualify)
- Must submit application and supporting documentation to the program upon securing full time or part time permanent employment within 1 year following their graduation
- Have permanent residence located no more than 100kms from the eligible community in which they wish to return service; or attended high school, for at least one full year, no more than 100kms from the eligible community
- Provide proof of tuition fees paid for each academic year form nursing school they attended.
- Commit to and sign a return

Provincial Community Commitment Program for Nurses

The County of Renfrew is offering a **\$25,000** financial incentive through the provincial government's Community Commitment Program for Nurses (CCPN) to an eligible Nurse Practitioner in exchange for a two-year employment commitment.

To be eligible for the financial incentive, you must:

- Not have been employed as a nurse in Ontario in the six months prior to being hired
- Hold a Certificate of Registration in good standing from the College of Nurses of Ontario
- Begin employment between April 1, 2024 and March 31, 2025
- Commit to 2 years of employment at a full-time work schedule with the County of Renfrew



• Not simultaneously receive funds from the Ministry of Health for the Tuition Support Program for Nurses.

Incentives for New PSW Graduates

The government of Ontario is providing incentive funding to attract personal support workers (PSWs) to work in long-term care homes as well as home and community care agencies. The incentives provide:

- A **Clinical Placement Stipend of \$5,540** during their clinical placement in a long-term care home;
- A **Return of Service offering \$10,000** to recent PSW graduates in exchange for a 12 month commitment to work in a long-term care home; and
- A Rural, Remote, and Northern Relocation Support fund of an additional \$10,000 to aide with relocation costs for recent PSW graduates committing to work in a long-term care home in a rural, remote, or northern area for 12 months.

Federal Student Loan Forgiveness Program

The Government of Canada offers Canada Student Loan forgiveness to eligible NPs, RNs and RPNs who work in under-served rural or remote communities that lack the primary health care they need.

The County of Renfrew qualifies as an under-served rural community.

If you are a **nurse or nurse practitioner** and you qualify, you could receive up to \$20,000 in Canada Student Loan forgiveness over a maximum of five years (\$4,000 per year).
